

## **Marlow Convenience Center Guidelines**

The City of Marlow Convenience Center (the “Dump”) is located southwest of the city of Marlow on McKinley Road. It is 1.5 miles south of Caddo Road and about 1 mile north of State Highway 7.

It is operated under the South Central Oklahoma Environmental Authority contract by Waste Connections.

### Summer Hours of Operation (March through October)

Tuesday and Thursday – 2 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Saturday – 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

### Winter Hours of Operation (November to February)

Tuesday and Thursday – 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Saturday – 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

### Requirements

Residential garbage only – NO commercial waste is accepted at this location. Refer to the Duncan Transfer Station for commercial waste and price schedule.

A current (the current or one-month previous) City of Marlow utility bill must accompany a matching photo ID.

A signature on a sign-in sheet

Residents are allowed 3 loads of garbage per month as part of their monthly sanitation fee with a maximum of 6 loads over any 2 month period, as follows:

1 load = a pick-up load

2 loads = a single axle trailer

3 loads = a double axle trailer OR a single axle with pick-up load

The utility bill may be punched accordingly.

People living outside the city limits are not allowed to take garbage to the Marlow convenience center, but may take items to the Duncan Transfer Station for a fee. For more information, see the Transfer Station guidelines on the city webpage or by calling Waste Connections, 580-252-1422.
