

Your Single-Stream Recycling Program

A Single-Stream Recycling program with 96 gallon poly-carts with an every other week collection schedule.

Each residential customer is provided one 96 gallon recycle poly-cart with wheels and lids. Containers will be identified as a recycle cart to differentiate from the trash container. Each container will have a sticker on the lid explaining the acceptable items. Those wishing to get additional Recycle Carts can contact City Hall to request one.

The contractor will pickup Curbside and recycle the following commodities in the program which may vary with market conditions but will customarily include:

Acceptable Items:

- Aluminum cans and Bi-metal cans/Steel and Tin cans
- Flattened Cardboard, chipboard, paper bags, office papers and junk mail
- Newspaper, sales paper, magazines
- Glass bottles and Jars: Green, Clear and Brown
- Plastics Containers: Milk, Water, Soft Drink Bottles, detergent and shampoo Bottles number 1-7 (no plastic bags of any kind)

All materials may be discarded together, but must not be bagged in plastic bags.

All residents will receive a collection calendar to note their recycle days or one can be obtained by going to your City website, to City Hall or contacting Waste Connections.

The guidelines for putting the container out at the curb for collection are the same as those for residential trash collection.
