

Transfer Station Guidelines

The Waste Connections Transfer Station (commonly known as “The Dump”) is located southwest of the city of Marlow on McKinley Road.

It is 1.5 miles south of Caddo Road, and about 1 mile north of State Highway 7.

The transfer station is manned by Waste Connections, and therefore, Waste Connections’ rules apply to the handling and acceptance of waste at that location.

SUMMER HOURS (During Daylight Savings time)

Tuesday and Thursday – 2 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Saturday – 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

WINTER HOURS (During Standard time)

Tuesday and Thursday – 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Saturday – 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

REQUIREMENTS

Residential garbage only – NO commercial waste is accepted at this location

A current (the current or previous month) utility bill from the City of Marlow must accompany a photo ID

A signature on a sign-in sheet

Residents are allowed 3 loads of garbage per month free of charge with a maximum of 6 loads over any 2 month period, as follows

1 load = a pickup load

2 loads = a single axle trailer

3 loads = a double axle trailer, or a pickup with single axle trailer

The utility bill will be punched, accordingly.

People living outside the city limits are not allowed to take garbage to the Marlow transfer station, but may take items to the Duncan center for a fee. Interested parties should contact the Waste Connections at (580) 252-1422.
